
- 360 Evaluator

### **Description**

Advisors and sponsors can now view a new icon labeled "BlackRock Tools" on the Properties and Positions tabs of their APM models.

Upon clicking the icon, a dropdown menu appears with the options, "360 Evaluator" and "Scenario Tester." Clicking an option directs the user to the corresponding page on the BlackRock Advisor Center Tools domain with the position details from the Envestnet Platform.

### **Summary**

The platform now allows advisors and sponsors to access the BlackRock Advisor Center platform via a Single Sign-On (SSO) from the BlackRock Launch Pad on the ENV2 Desktop.

# **Scope of Impact**

The advisors and sponsors with access to the BlackRock Advisor Center will benefit from this enhancement.

### Configuration

The option, "BlackRock Advisor Center Tools" must be enabled in the existing brand value, *Enable External Services*, to allow users' access to the BlackRock Advisor Center. The option is disabled by default. The Envestnet admin users with configuration privileges can enable the feature, and it can be configured down to the branch level.



### **Description**

The BlackRock services no longer appear on the default Launch Pad. A new widget, BlackRock Launch Pad is now available on the ENV2 Desktop, which lists all the BlackRock services. The widget is visible only if one or more BlackRock services are enabled for the user. The users can click the respective links to access the corresponding BlackRock service via SSO.



Advisors can now log on to the BlackRock Advisor Center from ENV2 using the BlackRock Advisor Center Tools link in the BlackRock Launch Pad.
